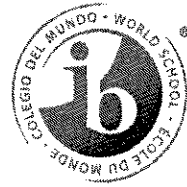

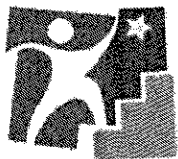

Please send these materials with your child on the first day of school.

- 2 folders
- 5 wide ruled single subject spiral notebooks
- 1 package wide-ruled, loose-leaf paper
- 1 composition notebook
- 1 graph ruled (quadrille) notepad - Available at Staples or Office Max.
- 2 boxes of markers
- 2 black Sharpie markers
- 2 boxes of colored pencils
- 4 boxes of number 2 pencils
- 4 small pink erasers
- 2 packs of glue sticks
- high quality mathematical compass*
- protractor*
- scissors*
- ruler*
- 1½-inch binder (PE - **6th graders only**)
- 1½-inch binder with dividers, loose leaf paper, and a spiral notebook (Spanish - **6th graders only**)
- 1½-inch binder for work portfolio (**only students new to E2**)
- supply box for markers, pencils, etc.* (optional)
- hand held pencil sharpener* (optional)
